Dear Miss Gilpin:

When we received your \$22.49 with the applications to convert policies 52,070,459, we did this effective April 23. We used the \$22.49 to pay the difference in premiums from April 23 to June 23 and a month's premium to July 23 with a credit of \$4.30.

The first indication that we have that you weren't entirely satisfied with your new policies was a letter written September 29 and received by us October 3. Your policies were lapsed at that time.

In this letter you enclosed a \$10.45 payment for a quarterly premium on your hospital indemnity policy.

I'm sorry that this letter was filed and went unanswered. However it does not affect the status of your policy.

At this late date, Miss Gilpin, we can do no more than to offer reinstatement of policies 52,070,459.

If you want your policies reinstated, please complete, sign and return the enclosed application with \$6.15 within ten days. This, with the \$9.01 check of October 11 and the \$4.30 on file, will pay the reinstatement fee and one monthly premium.

If we do not hear from you, we will return your check and credit.
