Your letter and the proof reached me yesterday too late to get you on the phone. Thank you for giving me the opportunity to change this order. Ofcourse the machine print will not do at all. So proceed with the 130 copies @ .75¢. I will have to make up on this some other way. I dont know what I was thinking of when I considered the machine prints. I guess I thought the first proof you sent was a machine print. I will have to make out on this some other way but I could not deliver prints like the machine proof, which doesnt even cover the negative.

So please proceed at once with this order on the revised basis. If you print these four to an 8x10 sheet, print as nearly as possible the whole negative. A border means nothing as I shall trim anyway. I have promised to deliver 25 of these to San Francisco by Dec. 12, so it looks bad. I enclose my check for \$73.50 whcih is the difference between amount already sent and total bill. Please send 25 or 30 of these by airmail SPECIAL DELIVERY. My street address is
