Your letter regarding photographs of petroglyphs came this morning. I appreciate Miss Sims' recommendation. I made a whole series of such material which was used in connection with a large exhibition of hers some years ago. Under separate cover I am sending for your inspection, some proof prints which I had on hand. There is one in particular that should make an exciting mural. My original on this is an 8x10 negative, fine grain film and fine grain development just for the purpose of a big enlargement. Your need interests me very much and I shall be happy to cooperate with you on this.

If I have anything you like I shall be glad to have the print made for you. I have done quite a few on these and there is one laboratory in particular which has done excellent work to my exact specification.

Have you considered at all the possibility of a large color print? I could re make this or any of these in color. The color would be very subtle and quiet and I believe yield a beautiful result.

I would need to know the size of the room, and the size of the wall and other decor for either black and white or color. I have in my studio two 30x40 dye transfer prints made for the State Dept. for a special exhibition at the opening of the Congress Hall in West Berlin 3 or 4 years ago.
