My own books are both out of print, but I hope that another year will see a third edition of Rio Grande. I am at present finishing another, this one on the Navaho, which I hope will be out by Christmas 1965. The only other book of mine is on the Maya ruins of Yucatan. It is still in print (Hastings House, Publishers, N.Y.) The price is \$6.
