I was out in the vicinity of Gallup all day on Nov. 25th, Monday, and then left early for Cortez Tuesday. I have my air shot of Mt Hesperous from Mesa Verde, and my, what a sight Mesa Verde is from the air!

Following Thanksgiving, I was very busy with Christmas work and since the first of the year, I have been having a lot of trouble with my back, very limiting. But I am back at work now on the writing, and will probably bother you again for some dates or statistics. And I am most curious to know what is happening at Window Rock.

I have gotten a very interesting identification of one pictograph I have and when I confirm this I will tell you. It quite changes my section on the Creation Story. I am rewriting it.
