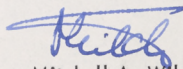
Dear Laura:

I hasten to make good on some of my promises of yesterday. First, I am returning to you the sample prints and proofs which you so kindly sent on for our consideration for use in the Utah exhibition. I wish to order exhibition prints of the seven items which I have transferred to the black envelope. On each I have marked in soft pencil the size print which we wish to have. We are working with a glossy unferro-typed paper throughout the show although some prints from other photographers are coming in on brovira 119. If you have a special pet which you think works better I will accept your recommendation and selection but as you know, I like exhibit prints to be rich and sparkly but without real gloss. A note on the 1931 picture of Betsy in the Hogan. Perhaps this will not go up to 11 x 14. If it will, this is our choice. All others should be 11 x 14 except the outdoor small Hogan scene which I would like to have as large as you can conveniently take it in view of the limitations of your dark room. If this is 20 x 16, okay. I would also like to have a 20 x 16 of the "Family in the Wagon" which is now over your fireplace, and the group gathered in the Hogan with your moon faced bootlegger looking sly. This also 20 x 16. This makes a total of nine photographs. Will \$25 per picture be acceptable to you? We, of course, will give you credit in the caption with the picture. When the prints are ready they should be shipped flat to us and we will mount them here.

I also enclose our check in the amount of \$200 representing payment for charges to date in the preparation of prints for the Indian Arts Fund Show and materials. At your convenience you can give me an accounting on this.

I hope Betsy is feeling better as the storm clears and winter improves. My fondest greetings to you both.
