Dear Miss Gilpin:

In an attempt to get the 4 x 5 film to machine print situation clear, let me say that we do not actually offer any machine prints from sheet film negatives. The price list that shows this service on Page 7, and the one to which you refer in your letter of October 7th, has been discontinued. We are enclosing a copy of the new list and the price for prints of this type may be found on Page 10.

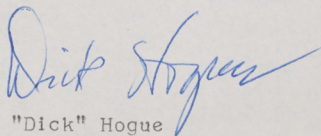
The areas listed in the instructions under these prices are approximate in that these prints are made on fixed focus machines and a different lens on different machines will have slightly different covering power.

To be on the safe side, you should use an area no larger than 3 x 4-1/8 inches. You will note that we do not make any machine prints from 5 x 7 negatives. If machine prints must be made from an existing negative, it will be necessary to make a commercial print and a copy negative to the proper size before machine prints can be made. Please remember that this will increase the cost and decrease the quality to some degree.

We trust this is the information you need. If we can be of further assistance, please let us know.
