Only 2 days ago Larry Bird + I
crawled into your wondrous cave
at Chichén Itzá. And we wondered
at the time you photographed it. Only
the ceramic plate, stone sculpture and
miniature matate remain - the
sense is awing and demands silence.
It was a joy. I regret you were not along.

Just now we are bathing + hammocking
+ coconutting etc. on Isla Mujeres, only 3 hours by
car + 1 hour by boat from Chichén. We
leave shortly for another 17 days before Hopi
Snake Dance.

It has been a good 3 weeks thus far.
Somehow the next school year will be better because
of the sun, the sea, the jungle, the maya +
the silent song of this architecture.

I wish you well, and send you
bit of turquoise water, a jungle voice or two
and sun thoughts.
