Gentleman:-

On behalf of Miss Elizabeth W. Forster, I am writing to you regarding the enclosed notice which we received to-day. To-gether with this notice have come two previous notices which have doubtless been here in Santa Fe for some little time. I call your attention to the fact that Miss Forster's name does not appear at all on any of these notices. As her niece to whom this policy is made out does not live in Santa Fe, and as there is no one by that name of Doyle at our address, it is small wonder that the Post Office has been confused about it. I did write to you once about this. Miss Forster, who lives here with me, and I get our mail at our post office box, not at our residence. The residence is a compound with other people living at the same number and they, of course, have no idea who Josianne F. Doyle is and had no idea that there was any connection with Miss Forster. It seems to me that the person who is to pay the bill should have his or her name on the envelope.

When your representative called on us, more than a year ago he did not give us a clear picture of this policy. However, both Miss Forster and I decided to take it out. My own policy you made out to my young cousin Kenneth N. Gilpin, III who lives in Virginia. I request again that when notices are sent for premium due, will you please see that my Name is on the envelope? This is the only way that delivery can be made certain.

Miss Forster has asked me to inquire if it is possible to turn this policy over to her niece now to carry on if she so desires? Due to her misunderstanding of the policy in the first place, the amount of \$150. per year is more than she can afford to carry. If her niece does not wish to do this, she will have to forfeit it unless you can make some adjustment for her. She just did not understand the policy at all when your representative was here.

Please advise her direct addressed to Box 1173,

Santa Fe, New Mexico.

I intend to keep my policy made out to Kenneth Gilpin III, provided that the notices are correctly addressed. If you cannot do this, I am not sure that I want to bother with it. My policy is No. 4253925.

Please let us hear from you immediately regarding these policies.

So there will be no confusion of numbers and individuals, I repeat here both policies and numbers
