Dear Mrs. Udall:-

It was indeed a pleasure to meet you last spring and to photograph the exhibition for you. I hope that I got material that was to your satisfaction and that the pictures will be used.

Yes, I am getting together a retrospective show for Jim McGrath (accent on the Indian Theme) and at the same time I am to have an all Navaho show at the Amon Carter Museum for Western Art in Fort Worth. Both shows to coincide with the publication of my book THE ENDURING NAVAHO being published by the University of Texas Press sometime about a year from now. I have received the formal notice that the book has been accepted but as yet the schedule has not been completed. I am very happy about this for it culminates the work of over thirty years among the Navaho People. All this looks like a very busy year for me. I suggest the show for you to come possibly as late as November 1967 if that would suit you. I wish I could be specific, but I do not yet know the book schedule nor Jim McGrath's for the show at the Institute.

Ofcourse I feel greatly honored that you wish to have this exhibition. Next year marks fifty years as a photographer for me, and I assure you that I shall be doing my utmost to produce a show of interest and of quality.
