Your negative arrived okay and we will proceed with your order as outlined in your letter.

As you know, the mural must be made in 2 horizontal sections, so that when mounted by others the seam will be above the people's heads. We will skive the edges where the 2 sections will overlap in mounting, thus the join will hardly be noticeable.

We will ship the mural to Mr. James McGrath, Center for the Arts of Indian America, Department of the Interior, Suite 5129, Washington, D. C. 20240...via Parcel-Post, on Monday, May 1st.
