Following my telephone call of a few minutes ago, enclosed please find the material I discussed with your sales department. I am sorry that this is such a rush job, but was quite unavoidable. These are for an exhibition of the work of three Indian craftsmen opening here on April 2nd at the Institute of American Indian Art. Later the exhibit will go to the Department of Interior in Washington D.C.

Tomorrow, I shall in all probability send you two more $2\frac{1}{2} \times 3\frac{1}{4}$ transparencies for 8x10 prints.

The person to whom I talked assured me that you could have these made and back to me by Thursday March 30. We could squeeze one more day, but these will have to be mounted and hung on Saturday. I don't like to work under this kind of pressure but sometimes it seems inevitable. According to your catalogue Page 20, the cost of the 11x14s will be \$28. the 8x10s 15. I enclose my check for \$75. on account and will remit the balance later.
