Mr. Roy Rosen of Santa Fe has told me of the color work you are doing. I very much want to have work done closer to home than I have been doing, and I am enclosing the following:-

4 sheets 4x5 Ektachrome film.
test sheets on a very difficult job.
Light so low it didn't register on a Weston meter & my S.E.L. is in N.Y. being repaired. This is a small chapel up in the mountains, where there is no electricity so I shall have to use flash. These are open flash exposures.

Also in this package are some 2½x3½ Ektacolor negatives. One, The outdoor scene will be a large order- 200 four x five prints. No. 1 is the customer's choice. This proof is from a sheet of eight exposures. No. 2. is right for value and pretty good for color. I believe that No. 1 will print adequately though it is a shorter exposure. Will you make me a proof (4x5) of No. 1 and let me see it first, please. Also there are 3 2½x3½ out door portraits. Please make one print of each, approx. 5x7. Cropping as indicated.

I will appreciate your price list etc. and hope that there will be more work in the future. I enclose \$5.00 on account, and will send the balance when I know what it is.
