Dear Mrs. Massey:-

I delivered the final prints for the catalogue for the McGrath, Scholder, Lolama exhibition on Monday. Before Jim left for South America, he brought his paintings to be copied and the give me his instructions. I told me that your budget for this catalogue was \$150. and wanted to know if I could make the two color copies, and seven black and whites plus the cover photograph for this sum. I assured him that I could. Compared with my regular prices this was slightly less, but I am only too glad to contribute a small amount. After Jim had gone, Fritz Scholder brought out an extra black and white and Mrs. Lolama and additional piece of sculpture. Then Fritz called about extra color transparency for the newspaper as well as a black white. All this by way of explanation for additions to the bill. However, you do whatever you see fit in this regard. I include my regular rates which are similar or below the standard commercial rates. Eastman Kodak went up 12 1/2% on all black and white film and paper a short time ago. The most difficult job of all was the Alaska sculptures which Jim wanted done against a pure white background and with no shadows. On these small objects this was difficult and I don't think the final result equaled the work entailed.

I am beginning work on my show and I will see Jim when he returns as to dates for this here before it goes on to you in Washington. Another delay on my book alas, but not much, but my show in Fort Worth is now scheduled to open Dec. 12.
