I was horrified to realize that I had neglected to follow through on the mounting of the enlargements. Mr. Wilder was scheduled to be here in Santa Fe a day or two after you called me, and I expected to hear from him all day. Then the next day I found he had not come. I am sure you will probably have the prints made by the time this reaches you, but in case here is a duplicate. As I remember, I also wrote on the back of the prints I sent or on the negative envelopes.

My book is off to an unbelievable start. Over three thousand copies sold in the first three weeks. I have been kept hopping with a thousand and one things to do. I am leaving here on Monday for Austin for another T.V. broadcast, and then up to Fort Worth. I will be there from Tues. eve until Friday noon with the opening of the exhibition Thursday eve. So I will have time to do what spotting is necessary.
