Dear Mitch:-

Here is a copy of the list we made some weeks or months ago. I have found a few duplications in the group displays, but that is no matter. There are several decisions to make. Selection of color prints and sizes thereof. But the most important decision is about my show here at the Indian Institute. Some months ago when I was assured that the book would be out in October, I promised Mrs. Udall that the show for the Dept. of Int. could be in January, 69. This means a showing here prior to that. Before I talk to Jim McGrath I need to know if you have any objection to a showing here a short time before yours? Three weeks is long enough here and we could schedule this to fit publication day Nov. 15th (we hope!). Jim's show will include a good part of the Navaho which I want to print at the same time I do yours. His will also include other material, Pueblo Indian, Archaeology, Southwest and Yucatan, and possibly that small gallery of early work!. Have just made out a work schedule for myself and I shall have to produce an average of 10-12 finished prints a week if I am to make the grade.

At the moment this is all I think of until I see you or talk to you.

With your not being connected with the book venture I take it that the date of Dec. 12th is final. Or do you want to have this show at all? If you have more important things coming up don't hesitate to say so. You know how much I appreciate all you have done to get this underway, and I know your plans for shows with publications, so don't feel bound now that T.U.P. is doing it all. I asked Frank several times about this and he never answered, so I did not know for certain until I got your last letter.

Hoping to hear soon when you will be in Albuquerque.
