Dear Mrs. Udall:

During our meeting with Miss Gilpin it was suggested that the following photographs and sizes be used as a starting point in gathering photos for her exhibit in Washington. She thought that there would be around 200 prints in black and white of various sizes and subject matter, possibly 14 mural size prints, 7 of them Navajo and about 14 color prints.

Because of the limited budget we thought a simple brochure would be all right and that the cost would not exceed \$750. The remainder would go towards transportation and exhibition costs, which would include opening, announcements, and installation costs. Would it be possible to include any amount for Miss Gilpin's printing expenses?

I understand that the dates for the exhibit would be from about January 15 to March 15, after which time the exhibit will be on loan to IAIA until sometime in May.

Miss Gilpin also asks that any reproduction rights be cleared with her.
