Dear Jim:

Kitty tells me that you are still feeling unsettled about the Laura Gilpin exhibition for the Center. I thought we made it clear when we met at your house on our last visit that we do want the show sometime in January 1969. Even though the Center will not be located in the Department of the Interior at that time, our budget from Government Services, Inc. runs through April 1969, and Laura's will be our last show. I think Kitty told you that we are budgeting \$3,000.00 per show, and since we will have no exhibition budget after Laura's show, we must stay within the budget for each exhibit.

We want very much to buy Laura's exhibition for use in the arts and native cultures program in Bureau of Indian Affairs schools. There is not money in the present budget for it but we are hopeful of getting a foundation grant and perhaps, then, it would be possible.
