Dear Laura:

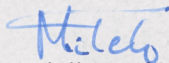

I am sure this would be a very heavy load, and in addition the trip would be difficult for you. Why not fly as our guest? It will be so much easier and less tiring. You must be the one to make the decision, however.

So soon as the show is ready I think it would be best to ship it along. This way we can go over things, see what we have in the way of installation problems, and have ample time to make plans. Also it would be better to ship the large prints unmounted, as we have good service on this work locally. You should, of course, allow the extra time at this end for spotting, etc. I would think you would want to come several days in advance of the opening.

Frank called yesterday and gave glowing reports of the book. I do hope that it is as satisfactory in your eyes.
