Dear Dick:-

Last evening I had another telephone call from Jim McGrath informing also that Mrs. Udall had told him that arrangements for a show in Washington should be negotiated between you and me direct, and that the Center would gladly loan the prints which they now own when ever they are needed. Having just written you yesterday that I thought that as the prints now belong to the Center that perhaps you should get in touch with Mrs. Udall. So I hasten this off to you.

Nor have I told you that a sort of catalogue, a brochure really, has already been printed. I am mailing you one under separate cover. Instead of the usual illustrated catalogue, Jim McGrath designed this which includes eight postcards, (very good reproductions). Fortunately there was no date or place printed, only the sponsorship of the Center for Arts of Indian America. There are I believe, 3000 copies of this being held here at the Institute of American Indian Art.
