Thank you so much for the two pictures you have sent me. The first one of Mr. McRea, Mr. Wardlaw and myself is an excellent press photo. I am ordering a few extras to send some friends etc. The second one amuses me greatly. What in the world was I spouting off about I wonder!

My Navaho show is still in New York, but closes on June first. I have been very neglectful in not writing to secure other showings for the summer months. I would certainly love you to have it whenever it best suits you. Colorado Springs wants it possibly Nov. 1st. Later would do, but I want to set dates with you first. September & October? Or would you want it for a longer time? I must let Colorado Springs know soon, I have just had a letter wanting to know when they can have it.

As to arrangements, I am supposed to get a fee for showing it (to defray my cost in preparation) but in your case because of the award I shall be glad to waive this. Otherwise it means cost of transportation from the last place of exhibit. It is pretty late now to find a summer showing. I you want it definitely, I can have The Riverside Museum ship it to you sometime in June and perhaps you will have a place where it can be stored until you are ready to hang it. It will be packed in two boxes, made to fit, and one crate containing the fourteen enlargements. These are 40"x60", and 20"x30" or tererabouts. As I wrote Mr. Woods, I will be glad to come over and help you install it when the time comes.

If you can let me know fairly soon what your decision is, I will make the arrangements with Colorado Springs to follow your showing.
