Dear Mrs. Allen:-

After I talked to you last week, I wrote immediately to the Riverside Museum to ship the prints to you. My letter was addressed to Mrs. Peter Farb, the Director, with whom I have had all the correspondence. As she was not in town, my letter was forwarded to her. This morning she telephoned the Museum and whoever is in charge in Mrs. Farb's absence, has just phoned me. I had instructed that the exhibition be shipped to you by Railway Express. The Museum's Curator advises me that Railway Express is very slow and she advised sending it by Air Express. The Railway Express, she said, is usually a week in picking up shipments.

So the exhibition will be shipped to you today and you should receive it in a few days. It will come to you collect, and when it leaves your hands it will go on to Colorado Springs collect, each exhibitor paying the shipping charges one way.

Do let me know immediately when you receive it so I can cancel the insurance which covers the exhibit in transit.

I do hope that you receive the shipment promptly. There will be two cases of prints, and one crate with the larger photomurals.

If there is any way I can help by letter when the prints arrive, do let me know. And at that time or soon thereafter, I will be free to come over if you wish me to do so.
