Please pardon my long delay in answering your letter. I am at the moment in Colorado Springs where I have an exhibit opening in a few days, of Southwest material. I brought your letter with me, and it seems that a whole week has gone by. Getting out of one's routine can sometimes be upsetting.

I shall be pleased to make you reproduction copies of each of the four photographs you are interested in; the exterior of San Esteban at Acoma; and the three pictures of San Jose, at Laguna. As I have done books myself as well as prints for various publishers, I prepare these with special care at \$10. ea, reproduction rights to come later should any of them be used. The most difficult one to print will be the Acoma one, for the carrying of equipment up to the Mesa top in 1938, jarred dust onto the film, (size 8x10) causing rather endless spotting on every print. However, I have done this for reproduction before.

I shall be returning home this coming Thursday and will glad to make these whenever I hear from you.
