Thank you very much for your letter of the 29th. It is good news about the possibility of my show at the Museum of Natural History. I hope that this will materialize.

The figure Jim McGrath gave Mrs. Udall was \$4026.55, being the amount for the costs of the color prints and the murals (\$973.45) being deducted from the \$5000. purchase price.

I cannot send you the number of photographs being purchased until the final selection is made. Jim cannot take the time for it during these first weeks of the opening of the Institute, and we have made a date for the 15th of September. I believe that Mr. & Mrs. Owings will be here at that time, and I should like them to be in on this final selection. As quickly thereafter as I can list the items, I will send all this information to you. Also a list of the prints I will loan to the CAIA for the Washington show. I trust the Jim McGrath also told Mrs. Udall that I am pricing the prints at my regular price less 20% for the size of the purchase. I trust that this seems a fair arrangement to all of you.
