Dear Mr. Muno:

There is still no word from the Emery Air Freight about the lost cases of prints. I am convinced that they were somehow badly damaged beyond repair and the loss is total. My lawyer is trying to get even an answer from them regarding this. In the meantime, I have heard from Mr. Wardlaw, Director of the University of Texas Press, that he feels the show definitely does promote sales, so I am trying to make up my mind about reprinting it. I am certain that I will reduce the size to perhaps 75 prints plus the photomurals. They did not leave Fort Worth until after I had left, so I had never seen them until now. I am very much pleased with them.

Would you still consider having this show at some future date? I think I can find some help in producing the prints and I am sure it would not take me as long as it did the first time.
