My apology for not having written to you long ago. I just dont seem to be able to keep up with correspondence as well as work. I am sorry that there has been such a long delay in getting your bills paid. My fault entirely. I should have sent in the Amon Carter bill long ago. It got under someother papers on my desk. It did go in more than a week ago. Mr. Wilder wrote me that there was quite a lot of spotting to do on the prints that went to him. And as you know they did not arrive in Fort Worth until after I had left. I had expected to do any spotting they needed. So Mr. Wulder called in a photographer to do this work for which he paid \$31.50. This I deducted from your charge for spotting etc. I dont doubt your giving the order, but perhaps you did not see the prints before they were shipped. Anyway, you may have received this check by now.

On the Washington show, there seems to be a holdup on getting the exhibition costs paid, due to the postponement of the show, and the change of administration in the Dept. of interior. I had been assured that the appropriation for these costs was in tact. I wrote to the Treasurer of the Center of Arts for Indian America, the sponsors of the show, on June second enclosing copies of the bills and invoices all O.K.ed by the head of the Art Department of the Institute here in Santa Fe. Both you and I should be hearing from them soon. If they, by any chance dont come through with this, I, ofcourse, will cover it.

Thanks for your inquiry about my book. It is moving well, I believe, but the publishers dont let me know naything unless I ask specia ly! And they only pay royalties once a year Oct. 1., so I still dont know any exact figures. They printed a large first edition of 7500. The slaes a past the 5000 mark, just how far I dont know, so that I hope edition one will be gone by the end of the summer. The New York show of the prints was very well received so I hear. I am coresponding now about other presentations of the show. Again my thaks
