8"x10" proof as requested. We are also
returning the 11x14 C print made.

#4 - Two Potters - made 2 - 8"x 10" color prints.

#16 - Yucatan Potter - returning the first 8"x10" print made.
This cannot be improved upon.

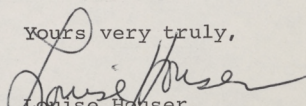
#1 - Pueblo Indian with corn - returning the 11x14 print made.
This cannot be improved upon due to the age of
your original, and because we printed it back-
wards, our Credit Memo 6878 is enclosed to
cancel original billing.

#22 - Portrait of Lucy Lewis - we are returning the original
11"x14" print made and the new 11"x14" print
made from the same negative to match your 4"x5"
color transparency of same woman different pose.

We notice that your negative of Lucy Lewis was shot on Ektacolor
Type L film. Whenever your exposure is shorter than one second,
you should use Ektacolor Type S film; whenever your exposure is
more than one second then you use Ektacolor Type L film.

We hope that the above resume will complete this job.
