Mrs. Udall spoke at great length with Jim when she was in Santa Fe recently and they discussed deducting expenses that have been incurred in assembling your exhibition from the number of photographs which the Center is purchasing. Jim gave Mrs. Udall a figure and she has misplaced the exact amount -- she recalls it was in the neighborhood of \$4,000 but we need the exact figure as well as the number of photographs being purchased.
