marked my ~~for~~ choice from 1 to 6
in pencil on the back in the lower
left hand corner. As you may have
guessed, I have not had occasion to
deal with photographers so this may
not be the right idea, but I would
like one print of each of the ones
marked from 1-6. Perhaps the six
prints all have to be of the one proof
according to our arrangement. In
that case, of course, I would like the
one I have chosen and marked no. 1
in the corner.

I feel that I would like to leave
the framing of one print (1 only)
up to your good judgment and I
would like to have the best enlarged
(I think the middle of me does

not look very flattering in
some of them. So I assume that
would not show so much if ~~that~~
^{the} part ^{with} of the head were enlarged.

I feel that you would know a great
deal more about the framing than I.
You know that my preference is to have
it on the snail side but you will know
how much if any matting is
needed, etc. It is only the one
that I would want framed now.
The others will be for relatives
and think it may be that some
of them will want to put them in
an album rather than a frame.

Thank you for your prompt
reply. I will look forward to
receiving one framed and 5
unframed prints if that is
agreeable with you.

that I am undergoing one of

will give me a number of happy
years ahead, but the side effects
affect at least temporarily my
