I am very sorry to hear that you have been unable to locate the missing crates.

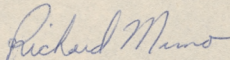
We would be interested in having your show at a future date. However, our schedule is filled for this coming year unless something should happen that postpones our scheduled shows.
