You are invited to submit photographs for possible publication in U.S. Camera Annual 1971. To be considered for the Annual, they should reach us by May 1, 1970.

Black-and-white and color prints and color transparencies are eligible. We prefer 8x10 to 11x14-inch prints, but accept good photographs in any size. Please write your name and address clearly on each print and slide, and enclose sufficient return postage if you send your pictures by mail. Pack with care, using photographic paper boxes or stiff cardboard larger than the prints to prevent damage in shipment. Address them to U.S. Camera Annual.

We buy one-time reproduction rights for pictures published in the Annual. The photographer retains all rights. Payment is \$35 per black-and-white picture used and \$150 per color photograph.

The Annual is a showcase for the best in photography, regardless of subject or style. This year we will concentrate mainly on photographs made for the love of it; this soft-pedals but does not rule out professional work done on assignment. I suggest that you simply send those pictures that you feel represent you best.
