and often painful illness.

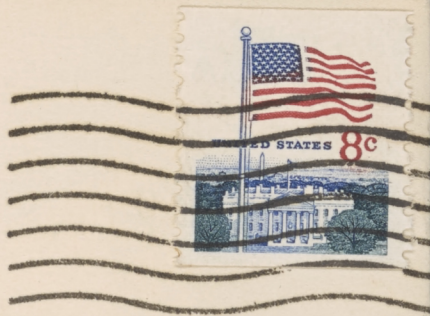
We really couldn't have
