Dear Miss Gilpin:

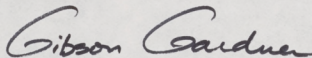
I hope the prints which you lent us were returned safely to you via Continental Trailways. I asked my sister to alert you to their arrival, and have tried to telephone you several times without success.
