Worked one year in a sculpture class under Brenda Putnam, to understand form. With Miss Putnam spent five months in Europe studying the galleries in France and England. Practised my profession in New York, Colorado, and New Mexico. While in Colorado was on the board of the Taylor Museum and later board of the Colorado Springs Fine Arts Center. Moved to Santa Fe in 1945.
