You will find enclosed photocopy of the label on the portfolio of your photographs of the "Camille" production at Central City. There are twenty-seven mounted photographs of the cast and scenes on 11 x 14 mounts. This collection must not have been the same as the one you showed me as there are no autographs by the cast. Each photograph is identified by one of your labels pasted on the back of the mount. This portfolio is also much smaller than the one in your collection.

It has been a little frustrating to try to find the names of members of Governor Gilpin's family. The obituary of his daughter, Mrs. Marie Louise Gilpin Dodson (Mrs. E.
