"Eternal Triangles", an acrylic and aluminum construction, was the "Juror's Choice" in the 4 state competition at Southern Colorado State College Exhibition. It is now in the private Collection of Roger d. Schultz, Santa Fe artist, architect, designer.

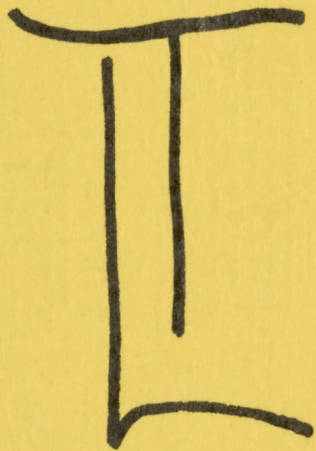
