have the illumination field larger than the neg-
ative (in all directions and positions). And the
longer the focus⁺ of the enlarger lens the better.
I would favor the Componon, although the Roden-
stock is a FINE lens. I am not sold on the Artars
as they are sometimes not good at all.

I had a lecture at the Met. Am having an
exhibit next year there (May-June?).

* Enlarging lens at least 13-14 inches!!
