On a recent trip to New York, I had a visit with my long time friend, Barber Morgan. She showed me the Archival Print Washer she obtained from you and which impressed me very much. Now that I am home in Santa Fe, I find that Dr. Richard Rudisill has bought one of these from you. Both he and Mrs. Morgan recommend the washer highly.

Mrs. Morgan showed me, or gave me, some literature about the washer, and in the course of traveling about I seem to have lost it. As I remember you make these in several sized. I will need the 16x20 size with the 10 print capacity. I believe that this size also holds 8x10 and 11x14 at the same time.

Also, as I recall, the size I need is approximately \$175. I am enclosing my check for this amount and hope that you will be able to ship this as soon as possible. Please send me your information on this washer and the necessary method of installation. Mrs. Morgan also told me to ask about a drain spigot.

As I have two special exhibitions coming up as well as other work to be done, I need to install this as soon as possible.
