This has much spotting to be done.
Dust from vibration of plane.
- No. 10. Red Rock Trading Post p. 84 book.
Will include this as an alternate.
- No. 11. Covered Wagon. Very difficult to
print but have a copy neg. which I will try.
- No. 12. You saw a good print. The image on
the rock was faint, and the texture of the
rock may be what is bothering you.
- No. 13. This could be a good one. will send.

I have a new air shot, 1973, which I have not yet
done anything but proof. This is not of deChelly, but made
but made on the way home. Will clear with the
School of American Research, but I feel sure this
is free of the School project. Feel this one of
my best and it is very recent. Then what about
page 62-63? In this last printing of the book
this seems to have lost delicate values in the sky.

We had not even thought of platinum when we first
discussed the portfolio. The cost and time involved
in including one platinum would be excessive. Will
