Dear *Laura,*

The Historic Santa Fe Foundation has succeeded in purchasing the Pinckney R. Tully House, thus preventing its demolition, an act which would have been most unfortunate for the historical character of Santa Fe. The Tully House, which has undergone no major alterations since its construction 123 years ago, is one of New Mexico's few remaining classic examples of Territorial architecture. The enclosed material provides a detailed history of this house.

As I know you are deeply interested in historic Santa Fe, I am appealing to you for help. A total of \$100,000 must be raised, \$60,000 of which is currently borrowed on a short term basis and must be liquidated in the near future. As time is short, we urgently ask that you give this matter your immediate attention. Your contribution, which is tax deductible, will be greatly appreciated.
