Dear Mr. Welcher:-

Here are three negatives of mine all of which you have printed before in mural size. My retrospective show is over, it goes next to Colorado Springs and will be routed by the Western Asso. of Art Museum period of two years. For this traveling show I need three prints, approximately 44 x 18. These will be mounted in 20x24 in cut out mats and framed that size. I thought that I would make these myself, but I have run into difficulties with air shot and my ancient Elwood enlarger and I know full well the kind of prints you can make for me. In addition to the traveling show, I have made an unbelievable number of sales, four prints of these negatives in this size, and I should have one additional to have here at home.

The air shot as you will remember is from a 4x5 neg, and the part to be used is the same print enclosed. You made me a wonderful 30x40 print of this which has been here in the show.
The order is as follows:-

If you will send these to me here I will be ready with the cut outs etc.
