Dear 1974-75 Members and Prospective Members for 1975-76:

We are happy to announce another season of distinguished concerts for 1975-76. Please note artists and dates on the reverse side of this letter. The regular series of four concerts will be *open to Members only*. For the fifth and extra concert, the Albuquerque Symphony with Pinhas Zukerman as violin soloist, 1975-76 Members who purchase tickets at the time of subscribing to the regular series will get a reduced price.

Please note the following *important changes* in our plans for next season:

1. The four concerts of the Membership Series will be presented in St. Francis Auditorium (Fine Arts Museum). Considering acoustics, location, audience safety, capacity, rental fee, and availability, we believe this is the best hall in Santa Fe for our concerts.
2. Due to the change in our seating policy (see paragraph 4 below), we shall be able to accommodate fewer members than are currently enrolled. You must respond promptly to guarantee hearing these concerts. Until April 10 Memberships will be available only to current Members. Thereafter new Members will be enrolled.
3. Increased costs and reduced seating in 1974-75 made it necessary for us to call on a few generous contributors to help meet our deficit. At this time we are inviting all Members to help us with a probable deficit in 1975-76. Patron Memberships will be \$25.00, regular Adult Memberships will remain \$15.00, and Student Memberships will be \$10.00. Contributions (tax-exempt) will be welcome in any amount.
4. Patron Members will be assigned individual reserved seats in St. Francis Auditorium, in a section beginning with the second row. Seats will be assigned in order of receipt of payment. Regular Adult Members and Student Members will be seated in the unreserved sections of the Auditorium according to traditional Association policy, first come, first seated. Names of contributors will be printed in the program. Patron Members who purchase tickets for the Albuquerque Symphony at the time of subscribing will receive preferred seating on the floor of Sweeney Gymnasium.
5. All Members who purchase their tickets for the Albuquerque Symphony at the time of subscribing to the 1975-76 season will receive a reduced rate at that time only. Admission to the Albuquerque Symphony concert will also be available to the general public at a later date.
6. Due to our limited seating capacity we are reluctantly cancelling our policy of reciprocal admission with the Los Alamos and Las Vegas Concert Associations.
