Dear Miss Gilpin:

This letter will constitute an agreement between you and Witkin-Berley Ltd. Please sign one copy and return it to us.

1. Witkin-Berley, Ltd. will produce fifteen portfolios plus five artist's proofs. Each portfolio will contain six original platinum prints as per our mutual selection:

- 1) Central Park 1917 (SNOW STORM)
- 2) Black Iris 1932
- 3) Church
- 4) Georgia O'Keefe holding pot. 1976
- 5) Indian woman holding lamb and child
- 6) Shepherds at dusk

2. All prints are to be printed by you and dry mounted on 14"x 17" 100% acid-free rag board.

3. All prints are to be signed and dated by you on the face of the mount (just below the lower right hand corner of the print.) Each portfolio will be signed in the introduction by you.

4. Witkin-Berley, Ltd. will supply the portfolio boxed, interleaves printing of the foreword and introduction, and assemblage of each portfolio.

5. You will write a foreword to the portfolio describing the pictures, your attitude toward and/or your philosophy of photography, or anything else that you would like to say about your work.

6. (Someone) Dick Rudisill will write the introduction to the portfolio.

7. Payments:

For your work you will receive \$10,000 payable as follows:
\$3000 when you have signed this agreement and begin work on the portfolio. (This we have agreed will be Jan. 1, 1977)

\$5000 when all the prints are signed and mounted and delivered to Witkin-Berley Ltd.
