Dear Susan;

Your letter came this morning and I am glad you have already scheduled the exhibit for Austin, Texas for next July. The first item of yours at the moment is prices, which are somewhat higher than they started out here in Santa Fe, due to more than one gallery. Lee Witkin in New York and Helen Johnston at the Focus Gallery in San Francisco have changed these. To go by number according to your Xerox copy, #101 called "Portrait, 1910" will stay at \$100, #102 "Still Life" change to \$100. All the platinum prints that started at \$250 have been doubled and are now \$500. Mrs. Johnston sold several and I have sold several here. That brings us to #1032, "The Temple of Three Lentels" at \$200. #'s 1033 and 1034 would be \$200 each (1035 is \$150, 1036 \$150, 1037 is \$150, 1038 and 1039 \$150 in 11 x14). Generally speaking, the prices are as follows, 8 x 10 \$100, 11 x14 \$150, 16 x 20 \$200. #1066 is \$150 (Rio Grande) as the size is slightly smaller than 16 x 20. #68 is \$50 still. #73 (16 x 20) is \$150 (correct title is "The Little Shepherd"). Most can be ordered at a smaller size for \$50 less. #86 should be \$75.

All the color prints should be \$100. It would be best if prints were ordered direct from me, as I will have to make them under any circumstances and the exhibit may have left the city where they were seen. I will try to make duplicate prints as soon as possible. At present I am slowly catching up to the original sales here which were many.
