Certainly the course would prevent them from doing very much work, but I amssure there is at at least one Navaho photographer who is on the staff of "The Navajo Times". The headquarters of this little newspaper is also at Window Rock.

I don't know if you are familiar with my book, "The Enduring Navaho", published by the University of Texas Press. I spent some 15 years securing all this material and my efforts are entirely from the indian viewpoint. I am very pleased to say that the Navaho people really like the book. But as to Navaho photographers, this is another story. However, there have been so many recent changes that you may be able to dig up somebody and I wish you good luck in this endeavor.
