Thank you very much for your letter of July 24. Everything seems to have been very busy here, and I am as always, slow in getting letters answered. I am interested that you have talked with Mr. May of the Denver Art Museum. I have a traveling exhibition out on the road now of the 100 prints covering a 64 year range. This is part of a large retrospective that opened here in December 1974. This was shown in Colorado Springs after it closed here and has been on the road ever since. The Western Association of Art Museums is routing this show and I am not certain what openings there are in 1977. A letter to them would give you their schedule.

I wonder if you know that I made a portfolio of platinum prints for the Central City Opera House Association after each performance of the Robert William Jones productions. I believe these are now in the hands of the historical section of the Denver Public Library.

My prints range from 8 x 10, 11 x 14, 16 x 20 with the possibility of 3 or 4 photo-murals, which I have had made for one exhibit or another. It appears I am scheduled for a very busy summer, so I thought I had better get all this information to you now. I am just afraid it won't be possible to get up to Central City, as much as I would love it. I am quite lame and don't get around as I used to.
