However, the guest room is at your disposal for any time you can be with me; and perhaps that would be more relaxing for you, with breakfast and other meals right here. I shall be most happy to have as much time as possible to visit with you, and will be pleased to drive you anywhere you may need or want to go and hopefully to have you see something of the most interesting parts of Tucson and the area.

My thanks to you for writing to Dr. Schaefer in my behalf. I expect to be able to see him soon.
