In regard to your inquiry about "The Cove"; we have a copy of that print which is not yet mounted or spotted. It is an 11 x 14 silverprint and I will be glad to forward it to you as soon as it is ready. When I refer to "spotting", I am speaking of minor touching-up on the photograph itself which is often necessary due to dust on the negative when it is printed. This shows up as a white spot which is made nearly, if not completely, invisible by spotting it. I am writing you about this as many people who purchase photographs are unaware of it and later find fault with the picture. If you would like to have this print I will have one mounted and sent to you, unframed. The cost being \$150.00 for the print and \$5.00 postage. Please let me know your desire and I will be happy to send you the print in about two weeks.
