Yesterday, we did a very thorough assessment of the stock of prints on hand and found we were even lower than we had suspected. Today Laura phoned Lee Witkin and the decision has been made that no more prints will be put out on consignment, and that anyone who wishes work for their galleries may buy through Witkin. We simply don't have the work to sell in large batches, or small ones for that matter, at this time. We are reluctant to do this, but right now there is little else to be done. You may still buy prints from us, but there is no longer a dealer discount. Of course, the prints you ordered are still to be sent you under the previous agreement. Hopefully, they will be sent to you within two weeks. I am sure you understand Laura's position. She has recently been confined almost exclusively to her wheelchair, as new and more serious deterioration has been made evident through X-rays. It is very difficult for her to move around and printing is out of the question right now. Thankyou very much for your interest and for handling Lauras' work this past fall.
