Enclosed please find my check for \$150.00 which you sent me originally for my photograph of "A Chance Meeting". I am quite aware what a long time has gone by since your original order came in. But, as many other prints were ahead of yours on the order list I have, and as I am no longer able to turn out work as fast as I used to, I know it has made a long delay.

In examining my print that you returned, I found that the two small areas which had been spotted had evidently been worked on, because they showed very distinctly in any light, which they did not do when the print was sent to you. The young man who is doing spotting for me now had spotted this so that it did not show from any angle whatever. At that time I did not have a new solution which can be added to the spotting solution giving an exact match to the surface of the print. The print has been re-spotted, but I would prefer under the circumstances to return your check. I am very sorry that this occurred.
